Meeting Summary

1. Ryan is working with Lisa on the newspaper announcement about the release of GSP Draft Sections 1 and 2 and request for public comments by July 17th. GSAs can also post this notice on their websites.
2. Contact with RD 800 requesting access to three monitoring wells: the next step is for Ryan to contact the County Recorders office to check if the grant deed lists a DWR access agreement. If not, Ryan will check in with RD 800 about transfer of ownership of wells from DWR.
3. Groundwater Dependent Ecosystems: LSCE will check that the DWR database was used to prepare the GDE map (it was). Ryan will provide contact information with the County Flood Control District to identify stream project (Three Creeks) in the Subbasin and/or if they can provide stream management/flood control information for the Subbasin creeks.
4. Three Modeling Assumption maps were approved with a few edits.
5. Future Subbasin water demand is provided in the IRWM and UWMPs.
6. City of Brentwood sent Prop 1 Grant funds to GSAs on May 29th.
7. ECC Subbasin GSP public meeting on July 9th: a pre-meeting will be scheduled to set the agenda and have a dry run.
8. DWR/Bill Brewster Report:
 - a. Critically over drafted GSPs comment period has formally ended.
 - b. DWR published a “Draft Drought and Water Shortage Vulnerability” report that is out for review.
 - c. TSS applications are being accepted but work would not be completed until summer 2021.
 - d. Groundwater Models: SVSim beta version and CWVSimFG beta are available.

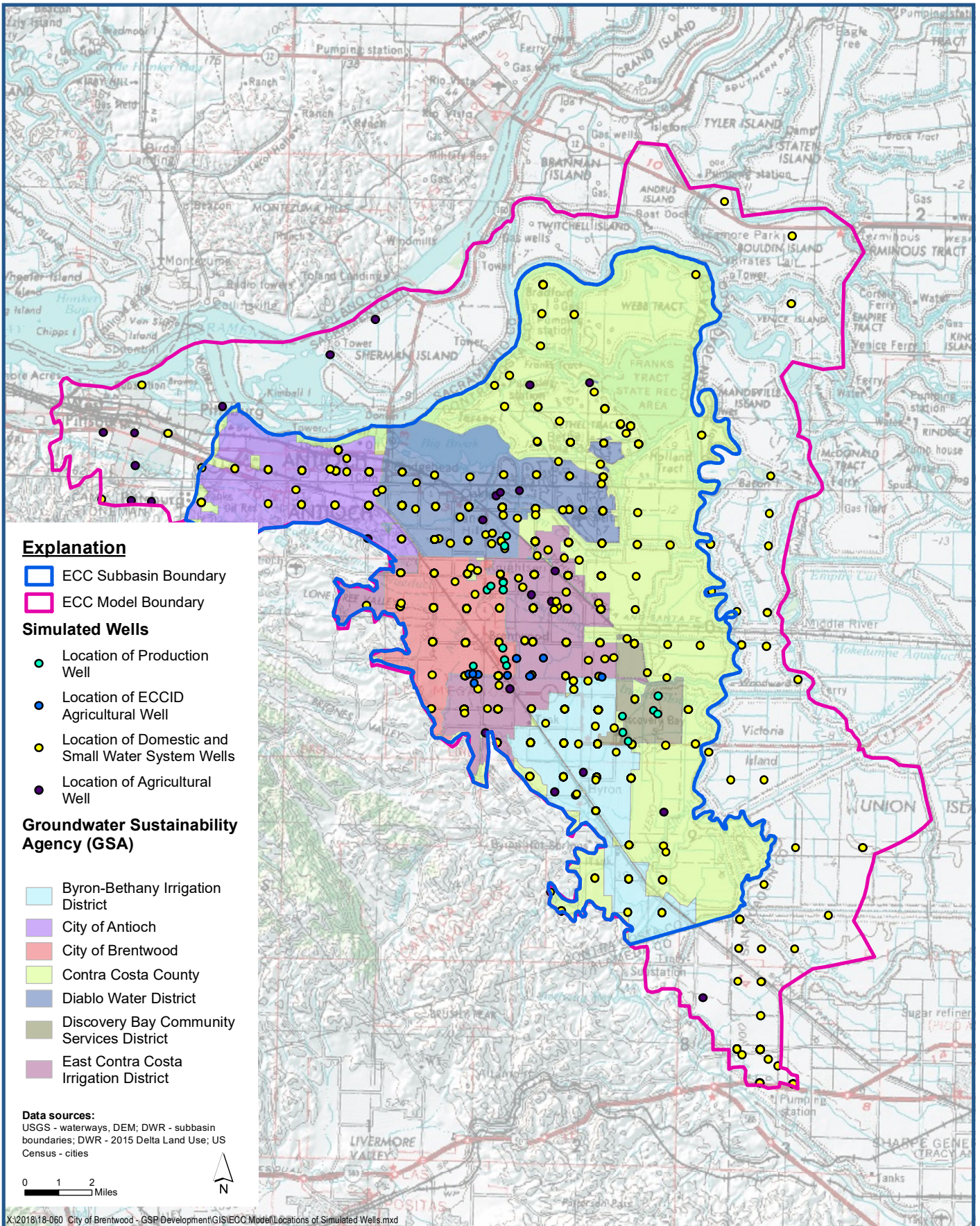

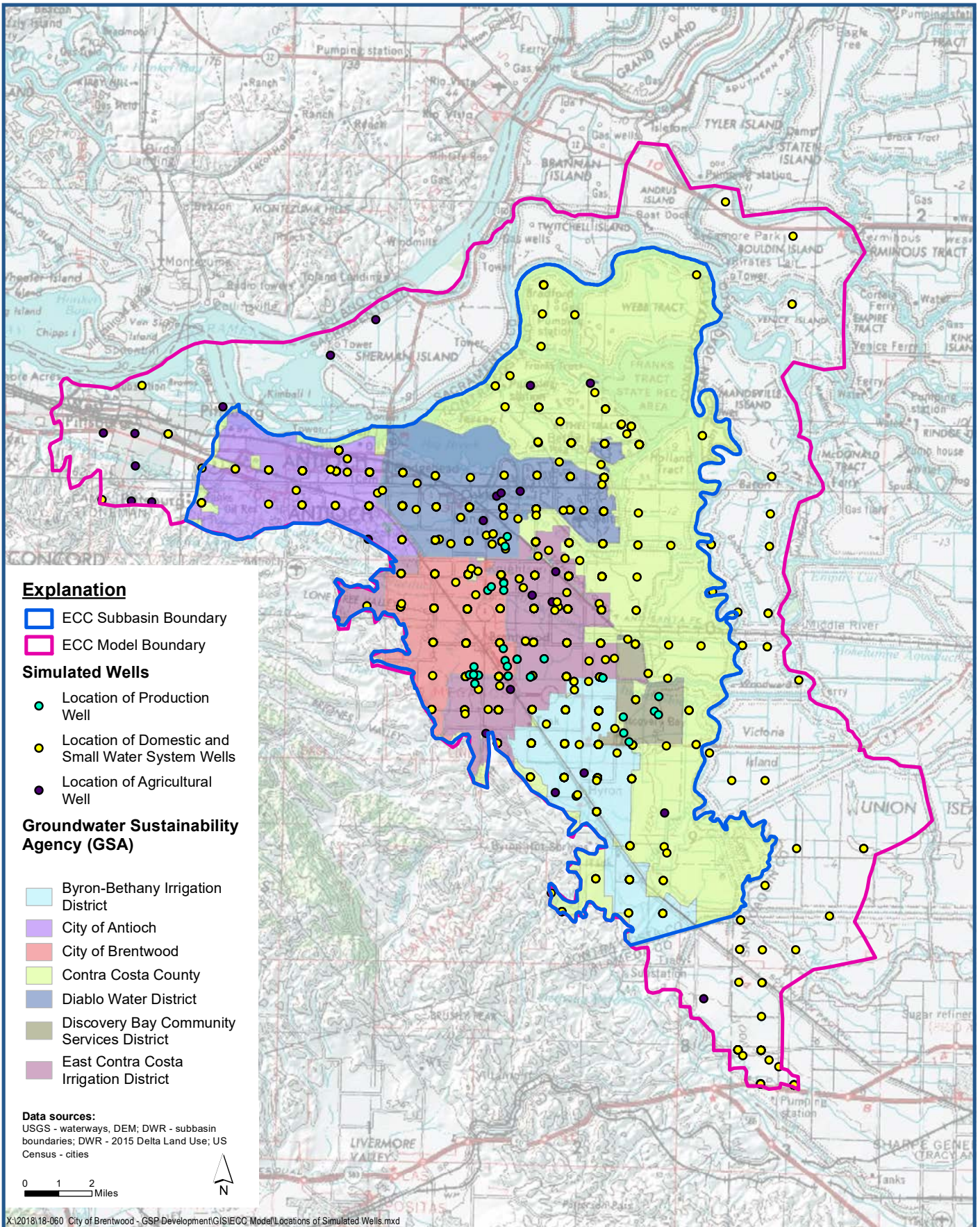

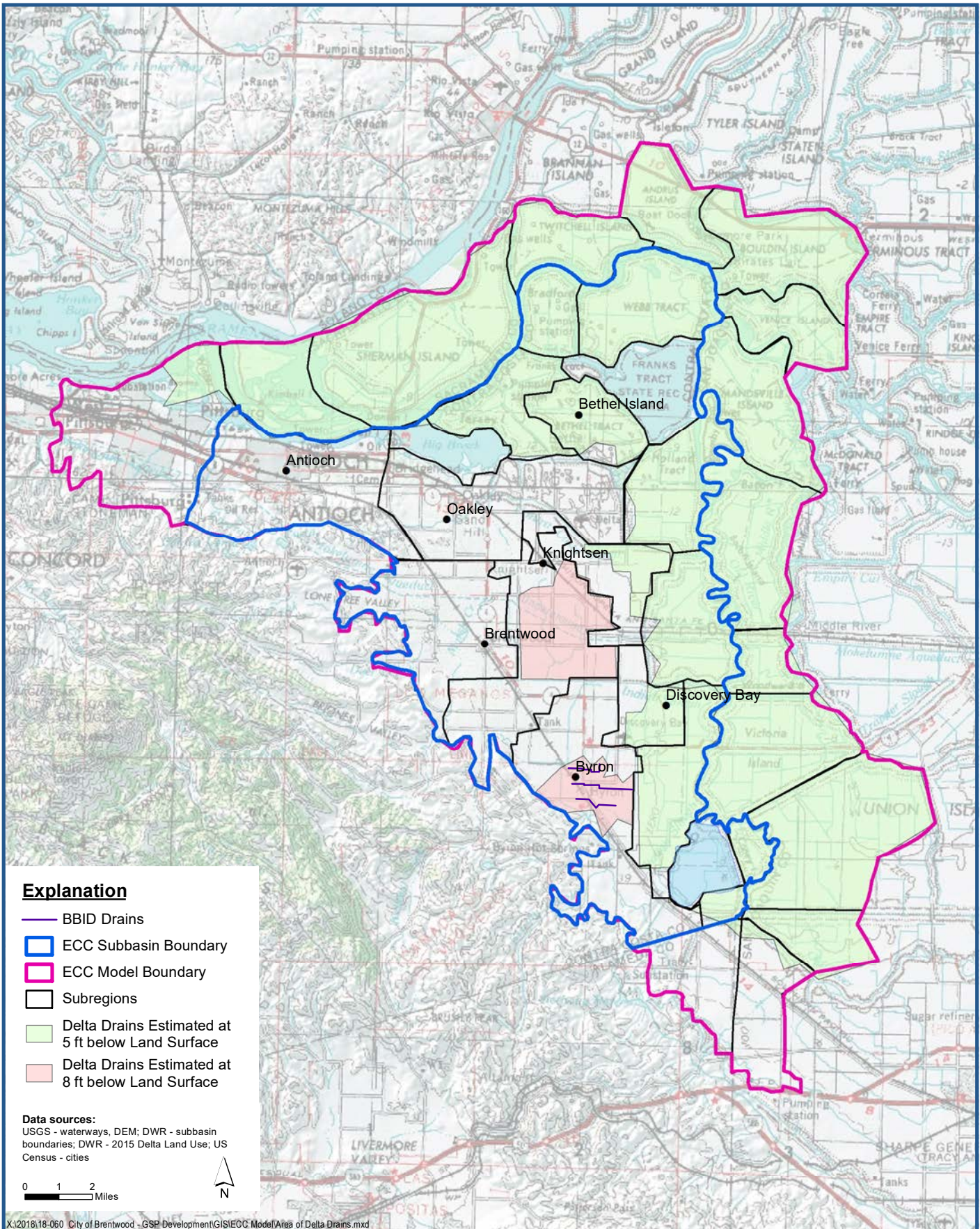
Attachment 1

Modeling Assumptions





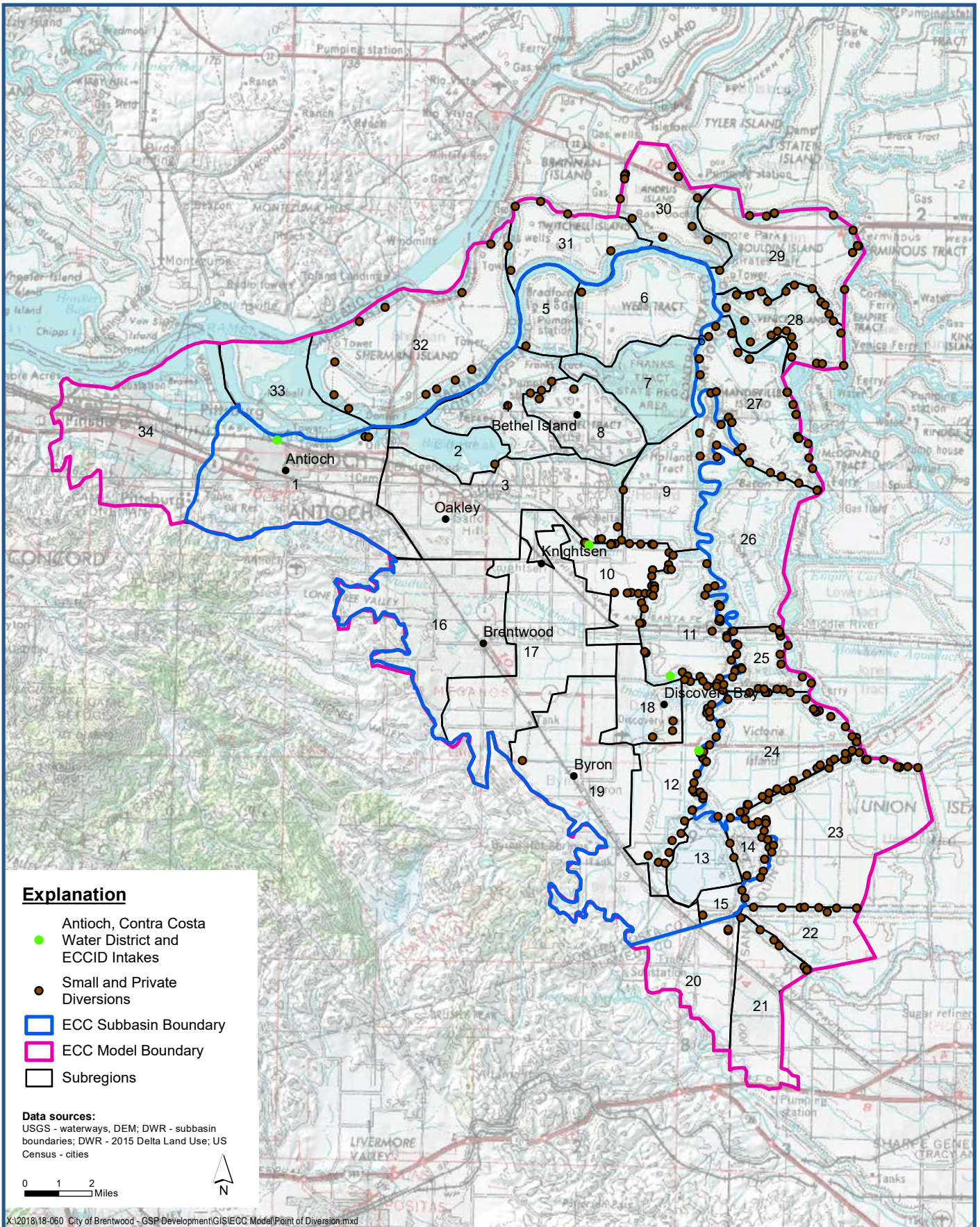


**Area of Delta Drains
