Summary

- 1. Three Prop 1 progress report/invoices have been paid by DWR (PR1, 2, and 3). PR4 has been submitted and PR5 is due January 2020. PR5 will include SJC (Tracy Subbasin) invoice.
- 2. Ryan sent out a draft MOU this morning, this will be updated with the invoice "turn around" is increased to 45 days. Comments are due back to him by Friday December 6th.
- 3. Ryan will send out the Resolution template to all GSAs tomorrow (11/20/2019). These can be put before boards/councils in January/February in order to meet the March 2020 deadline (e.g., potential Prop 68 agreement signing).
- 4. Brentwood will send out monthly invoices and reimbursements quarterly to GSAs.
- 5. Updating GSA information on SGMA portal: All updates needs to be finished by March 2020 (potential signing of Prop 68 grant agreement, if awarded). Antioch will update soon. BBID?
- 6. Discussion about how to find land for monitoring well installation. Aaron suggested looking at government and special districts (e.g., Delta Diablo, stormwater retention subbasin). City of Antioch will provide a GIS of city property to help narrow down potential locations.
- 7. Groundwater model for East Contra Costa Subbasin: Bill did not have status information on the CVHM2 (USGS) and the C2VSIM fine grid model (DWR) and suggested contacting Tyler Hatch at DWR for more information. Tyler responded with a release data of spring 2020 for both models.
- 8. DWR Updates:
 - **a.** Facilitation Support Services-the ECC/DWR agreement is in progress and DWR (Craig Moyle, facilitation team lead) will be contacting Eric to finalize.

- **b.** Technical Support Services-the hardest part is the location and agreements completed by GSAs. DWR and the GSAs may split some other parts (DWR may do environmental and cultural investigation and GSA may do traffic control).
- c. Prop 68 Implementation Grant draft PSP will be out in 2021 and awarded 2022.
- d. DWR Online GSP Reporting System-is up and running.

Once DWR approves the service plan, the facilitator can begin work. Technical Support Services (TSS) (general application approved 8/26/2019)-ECC GSAs will submit a request: 1) for installation of four monitoring wells including monitoring equipment. 2) downhole camera to determine well perforations for wells without well completion reports (DWD has 4-6 domestic wells with water levels from 2003 to present that may be candidates).
